

PRIVACY POLICY

Significant is committed to protecting your privacy to give you a safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Significant Website and governs data collection and usage. By using the Significant website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Registered Business Names

Significant and Significant Early Venture Capital are registered Business Names of Significant Capital Ventures Pty Limited ACN 607 951 986.

Collection of your Personal Information

Significant may collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Significant also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your postcode, age, gender, preferences, interests and browser favourites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Significant. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Website addresses. This information is used by Significant for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Significant Website.

Significant encourages you to review the privacy statements of Websites you choose to link to from Significant so that you can understand how those Websites collect, use and share your information. Significant is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Websites outside of the Significant and Significant family of Websites.

Use of your Personal Information

Significant collects and uses your personal information to operate the Significant Website and deliver the services you have requested. Significant also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Significant and its affiliates. Significant may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Significant does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Significant may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Significant may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Significant, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Significant does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as ethnicity, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Significant keeps track of the Websites and pages our customers visit within Significant, in order to determine what Significant services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customised content and advertising within Significant to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Significant Websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) comply with relevant laws or with legal process served on Significant or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Significant; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Significant, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Significant Website use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Significant pages, or register with Significant site or services, a cookie helps Significant to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Significant Website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Significant features that you customised.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Significant services or Websites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

Significant secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Significant secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
